Main tasks

- Undertake intake meetings with families to develop therapy goals
- Clear communication in therapy plans, GP letters, NDIS therapy plans, other allied health practitioners.
- Reviewing school reports and plan and working alongside school to support students.
- Provide specialist psychological interventions and participate in quality improvement initiatives
- Assess, diagnosis, consult, evaluate and provide treatment planning for complex presentations. This will also include the provision of evidence-based individual psychotherapeutic interventions that foster self-determination, hope, is person centred, goal directed and focuses on personal strength
- Keep appropriate, up to date and accurate clinical records
- Assess complex cases within the multidisciplinary team to support clients to flourish.
- Ensure the process of transfer and/or discharge of care is undertaken in a timely and effective manner, including written/verbal communication to all relevant parties and the completion of statistical and outcome measures
- Implement, monitor and review treatment plans
- Utilise Routine Outcome Measures
- Attend internal and external case conferences (in person and online)
- Working alongside other community organisations and businesses
